A slight change at half time, saw Joe Tosh move into the centre forward position and this instantly reaped rewards, with Joe scoring 2 goals and Finn and Charlie adding a 2nd each. At 6-1 up, Northallerton had done enough to secure the trophy. However Bedale did finish strongly and managed to pull 2 goals back. So final score of 6-3 meant Northallerton had won the plate and ended, or started a very good season for the now Year 8 team.
