Student Lanyards and Dress Code in the Sixth Form

All Sixth Form students have been issued with lanyards to wear at all times on the school site. The primary reason for this is to safeguard our students and to ensure that staff can clearly identify those individuals that belong on our site. The students in the Sixth Form do not wear the same uniform as lower school and as a result, students can often blend in very well with members of staff and visitors to the school.

It is vitally important that all staff and students can be clearly identified, to be able to tell immediately whether a person is meant to be here.

Sadly, many students are failing to wear their lanyards consistently despite requests from staff. Therefore, the decision has been made that students that are persistently caught not wearing their lanyards will not be allowed on the school site. The Sixth Form team and personal tutors will have the final say in this regard. Temporary lanyards will be available from the Sixth Form office on one-off occasions. This rule will be enforced from Monday 3rd February.

If students have lost their lanyard/pass, they are able to receive a new one, but students must make themselves known to the Sixth Form office.

We would be grateful for your help and support with this matter.

This is also a good opportunity to remind everyone of the dress code for Sixth Formers. Our dress code policy is casual, but must remain modest and appropriate for a school environment. Details are attached to the bottom of this letter.

YEAR 12 AND 13 DRESS CODE

Sixth Form Dress Code

At Northallerton College, students are permitted to wear casual clothing, but this must be modest. Students must avoid displaying extremes of fashion.

Hair

Artificial streaks or colouring that stand out in any way will not be allowed.

Dress

Students are asked not to wear strappy tops, bra straps should be covered at all times, and students must refrain from wearing cropped tops.

Clothing must not display offensive logos

Jewellery

Jewellery must be discreet and minimal. No facial piercings allowed.

Any final guidance on the Sixth Form dress code is at the discretion of the Head of School, students may be asked to return home if their attire does not meet the college standards.
