Dear Y11 Parent / Carer

Following from my recent letter on Friday 27th November I am writing to confirm that all Y11 students can return to school tomorrow, Wednesday 2nd December, providing that your son / daughter or anyone in the household does not have any symptoms of Covid-19. If they or anyone in the household are experiencing any Covid-19 symptoms, students should remain at home and self-isolate until they or the household member receives a negative test result. If they have been identified as a close contact of a confirmed positive case they should remain at home, self-isolate for the time period advised, and inform the school.

We have swapped around the teaching pod areas for the Y8, 10 and 11 year group pods. This is to allow each of these year groups to access practical science lessons for set periods during the current academic year. The majority of the practical science teaching for Y11 has now been completed and we will therefore be moving Y11 into the maths pod area. Therefore, Y11 students will enter and exit the school using the side entrance next to the nursery, opposite the police station on Crosby Road. This morning Mr Wilkinson produced a short video explaining the expectations and practicalities of this pod swap. This video has been uploaded to the Y11 Google Classroom and we would appreciate it if you could encourage your son / daughter to watch this at some point today.

During tutor time on Wednesday, tutors will welcome students back and provide them with their personal lesson timetables complete with the new rooming. On Thursday morning, Mr Wilkinson will be leading an assembly with Y11 introducing our revision and exam preparation programme and taking students through the year ahead.

Please can I remind all students to ensure they have their correct equipment and a face covering.
