Dear Parent/Carer,

Now that Year 11 students have finished their assessments, we would like to help them think ahead to the future. We will be providing support for all Year 11 students in order for them to make the transition to their next stage.

For Year 11 students staying on here at Sixth Form this will consist of two strands:

1. Bridging google classrooms will be set up for all subjects offered at sixth form (here and at Stokesley). Students will need a code to access these classrooms which will be available on the Year 11 google classroom. Work will be on the google classroom after half term. If students are unsure of their A-Level choices it is a good idea to join all of the classrooms of the subjects that they are considering studying.
2. There will be bridging sessions for all of the subjects offered at sixth form. If the subject is being delivered by Stokesley (further maths, sociology, politics, economics) these sessions will be delivered remotely and these will run Tuesday 8th June - Friday 11th June. **If you would like to attend one of these remote sessions please would you contact Mrs Redpath so she can arrange for you to have a google meet invite.** The bridging sessions delivered by Northallerton are planned to be Thursday 1st July and Friday 2nd July so you will be contacted with further details of these sessions after half term.

For Year 11 students who are not staying on at Sixth Form there will be daily careers activities, events and opportunities posted on the Year 11 (2020/21) careers opportunities google classroom.

GCSE results day will be Thursday 12th August and we will be in contact about arrangements for collecting these results closer to the time.

If there is any further support that Year 11 students need in order to help them as they make decisions about their way forward please contact either Mrs Redpath, Head of Sixth Form or Miss Robson, Head of Year 11.
