### **Uniform:**

Our uniform standards are important because they allow young people to focus on our core business - learning. We live in a world that is governed by laws, rules and regulations - to not prepare you for this world would be remiss of us.

- Trainers are permitted as long as they are plain black and polishable with NO air bubbles or high chunky sole
- ALL school skirts need to be worn at an appropriate length. They must not be altered to shorten the length e.g rolled up.
- No jewellery other than a watch and one set of plain studs, in the earlobe.
- Facial piercings are not permitted. Jewellery will be confiscated and if repeated confiscated until the end of the week, where parents will be invited to collect.
- Round neck sweatshirts and pullover head hoodies worn under blazers are not allowed. <u>They will</u>
   <u>be confiscated and if repeated confiscated until the end of the week, where parents will be invited</u>
   to collect.
- False nails, nail varnish and heavy make up are not permitted. If you arrive at school wearing these, parents will be immediately contacted and you will be sent home to remove them.
- Clear studs are NOT allowed!
- Outdoor coats must not be worn inside the school building.
- Mobile phones and headphones are not allowed to be visible/heard at any time in school. The
  School Grounds start at the main gate or as soon as you step off the school bus. It is at this point your
  phone and headphones must be out of sight.
- Phones will be confiscated if seen or heard and if repeated confiscated until a parent/carer collects from Reception.
- Refusal to hand over your phone will result in an immediate call to parents to reiterate our expectations.
- **For educational purposes,** a teacher may direct you to use your mobile phone if an alternative device is not available, for exit guizzes or to use Educake, for example.
- You must not contact parents/carers during the school day. If you need to contact home the school will do this on your behalf.
- Students not meeting these expectations will have their phone confiscated. You will collect your phone at the end of the school day. <a href="However">However</a>, if there is a repeat of this behaviour in a half term, the phone will be kept at reception until a parent/carer can come to collect it.
- Sweets, lollipops, chewing gum, family size bags of crisps/snacks, hot beverages and energy drinks/fizzy drinks are not allowed on the school site and will be confiscated and not returned.
- By sending you to Northallerton School you and your parents have agreed to our policies.

We ask all students to not be rude, disrespectful or refuse staff when they confiscate items or remind you of our basic standards and expectations. We are doing our job and caring about our students and their future life choices.

# All students are expected to wear the following uniform:

- Clip on tie (Y7 Blue / Y8 Yellow / Y9 Red / Y10 Green / Yr11 Black)
- Blazer These must be brought into school <u>every day</u> and if directed by the Headteacher, students will be given permission to remove them in warm weather conditions.
- V-neck knitted jumper Black optional (no other styles of jumper is permitted)

- Trousers/Skirts Trousers need to be formal and full length Skirts need to be black pleated and formal approximately knee length. Old skirts will be phased out over the next couple of years, so straight skirts are acceptable in Y8-11, however ALL skirts MUST not be rolled up.
- White shirt top button always fastened and tucked into skirts and trousers.
